**TITLE:** After school program teachers (6) at Bolger Middle School for 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC program (KAP)

**STIPEND:** \$32 per hour x 210 hours for certified staff. Stipend not to exceed \$6,700.  
\$16 per hour x 210 hours for non-certified staff. Stipend not to exceed \$3,360.  
Positions funded through the 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC grant.

**JOB DESCRIPTION:**

- Responsible for planning and organizing educational enrichment and recreational activities for fifth-eighth grade middle school students during after school hours from 2:40-5:40.
- Supervise homework help and develop and facilitate hands-on language arts or math remediation lessons twice a week. Lesson plans required.
